## \* Compulsory legal courses

Students have to complete at least 40% of the compulsory courses either in Portuguese or Chinese.

Students can go to study abroad in Year 2 (subject to the approval of the University of Macau) under the condition that they have reached the minimum Portuguese language proficiency at A2 level or above according to the CAPLE or CELPE-Bras (Certificado de Proficiência em Língua Portuguesa para Estrangeiros / Certificate of Proficiency in Portuguese for Foreigners) examinations in Year 1;

Upon completion of the study abroad programme in Year 2, students have to reach the minimum Portuguese language proficiency at B2 level or above according to the CAPLE or CELPE-Bras examinations:

If students fail to reach the required Portuguese language proficiency at A2 level by the end of Year 1 or at B2 level by the end of Year 2, upon return to Macau, they will be required to transfer to Year 2 of Bachelor of Law in Chinese Language Programme (Daytime).

# In the case of course waiver on the course "CPED100-Residential College Experiential Learning", students will be required to take the course "LAWS130-Enhancement Learning Activities" in order to fulfil the credit requirement.
