3. Applicants must possess the ability to develop a complete course syllabus and to arrange courses in accordance with the faculty's requirements.
4. Applicants must be bilingual and able to teach in Portuguese-English, Portuguese-Chinese or English-Chinese.
5. Preference will be given to applicants with teaching experience in tertiary education.

3. Detailed teaching plan for the applied course (15 weekly teaching plan)
